### ***NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARINGS FOR THE CITY'S FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN***

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City's draft Fiscal Year (FY) 2026-2027 Annual Action Plan (AAP) will soon be available for a 30-day public review period, and public hearings have been scheduled for the Human Relations Commission (HRC) and City Council to review and consider adoption of the AAP.

#### **DESCRIPTION OF THE ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The FY 2026-27 AAP is a one-year plan that will implement the second year of the City's FY 2025-30 Consolidated Plan as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The AAP identifies activities and projects funded by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) programs to achieve the City's five-year Consolidated Plan goals. The FY 2026-2027 AAP covers the period of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027.

#### **PUBLIC PROCESS**

Public Comment Period: The 30-day public review and comment period for the draft FY 2026-27 AAP begins on March 29, 2026 and ends at 11:59PM on April 28, 2026 in accordance with federal public noticing requirements.
